The Tyndall National Institute of Ireland has an 11-week summer research program for undergraduates that is open to all 2nd and 3rd year students majoring in science, engineering or math. International students as well as US citizens are eligible to apply. Topics include photonics, microelectronics, optoelectronics, nanotechnology for biological applications, computational modelling and related fields. Program dates for 2008 are June 16 to August 29. Application deadline is March 19.
